

# Cleveland–Redland Bay Road upgrade: Anita Street intersection Community Update

August 2020

## Cleveland–Redland Bay Road upgrade

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) is undertaking a package of works in order to upgrade Cleveland–Redland Bay Road. This \$60 million project has been divided into three stages:

- Stage one: Resurfacing key sections of Cleveland–Redland Bay Road. **Complete.**
- Stage two: Upgrading the Anita Street intersection. **Construction starting soon.**
- Stage three: Duplicating Cleveland–Redland Bay Road, north from the Anita Street intersection. **Planning to commence late 2020, construction to start in 2021.**

## Stage two – Anita Street intersection upgrade

### Key project features:

- Increasing the capacity through the intersection from two lanes to four lanes
- Installing traffic lights and a pedestrian crossing across Cleveland–Redland Bay Road and Anita Street
- Separated cycle tracks
- Upgraded footpaths
- Improved bus stops.

### Benefits:

- **Improved traffic flow on Cleveland–Redland Bay Road**  
The four-laning of the Anita Street intersection, which will then continue north via the next stage of the Cleveland–Redland Bay Road project, will help to reduce congestion along Cleveland–Redland Bay Road, improving traffic flow and ensuring that residents and visitors to the Redlands are able to get to where they're going more quickly and efficiently.
- **Safer intersection for motorists, pedestrians and bicycle users**  
Installing traffic lights at the Anita Street intersection makes entering and exiting Cleveland–Redland Bay Road safer and easier for the more than 200 households who use Anita Street, whether that is by car, on foot or by bike.
- **Improved, safer facilities for bicycle riders**  
The use of separated bicycle tracks will be continued throughout the Cleveland–Redland Bay Road upgrade. These cycle paths are separated from the road as well as other footpath users, encouraging bicycle riders of all ages and abilities.
- **Improved utilities**  
The intersection upgrade will also improve utilities such as drainage.

### What's next?

The Anita Street intersection upgrade will commence construction in August 2020. Works will include:

- Site clearance including removal of trees. The contractor will engage a qualified arborist to remove the trees to minimise impacts to remaining vegetation. TMR can advise that fauna spotters and catchers will be in place throughout the works. If any wildlife is located, it will be relocated to a safe environment where possible.
- Drainage works in preparation for roadway construction.
